**Date:** Monday, August 29, 2011 (this will sell out fast, and the # teams is limited, so get in quickly)

**Cost:** \$75 per person (3 mulligans are already included for each team)

**Format/Dress:** 4-person team Scramble / Captain's choice (best ball).  
Non-metal spikes. No jeans/t-shirts. Shirts with collars. If shorts, Bermuda style and length.

**Time:** **8:30am:** Range opens. Range balls are included. Snacks available upon arrival.  
**9:45am:** Call to carts for the Introduction and Announcements.  
**10:00am:** Shotgun start. Staff will lead you to your starting holes.  
**Approx 2:30pm:** Food is served in the covered outdoor area of the clubhouse.

**Food & Bev:** Before golf:

- Limited menu, sandwiches, snacks and beverages will be available upon arrival, for a nominal charge.

During Golf:

- Keg and water near the clubhouse.

After Golf:

- Main meal: BBQ with sides.
- Beverages: Whatever is left of the keg and water!

**Prizes:** Always subject to change!  
Three "surprise" team prizes! One could be for team spirit (dress alike or outrageous but suitable golf attire!)  
2 Straightest Drives (1 Men & 1 Women)  
2 Closest to Pin open to all (ball must be on the green, no fringe)

**Directions:** (Approx. 10 miles from LM IS&GS Civil at I-270 & Shady Grove Rd)

- Turn RIGHT onto Fields Road
- Turn RIGHT onto 370 (Sam Eig Highway)
- Take exit for METRO, but stay in RIGHT lane for Shady Grove Rd. (East).
- Merge onto Shady Grove Rd. going East.
- After about 1 mile, cross over Muncaster Mill Rd. (MD115) onto Airpark Rd.
- Turn RIGHT onto Woodfield Rd. (MD124).
- Turn RIGHT onto Warfield Rd.
- Turn RIGHT onto Dorsey Rd.
- Clubhouse is on your RIGHT.

**Outing Rules:**

- Questions, issues, or disputes with scoring or rules will be heard by the Golf Outing Committee: Oscar Mulford, John Sharp, and the Laytonsville PGA Professional Staff.
- Women always play from Red tees. Men will begin play from the Blue tees. Birdies will force the men to move back a tee (until reaching the Black); bogeys or worse will allow the men to move up a tee (until reaching the Red). Pars remain on the same tee.
- Under scramble format, you must place your ball within one club length of whichever ball is chosen as the "best ball," without improving the lie (e.g. rough stays in rough, fringe stays on fringe, sand in sand, etc.) except on the green the ball must be placed as close as practical to the "best ball" without improving the lie.
- Mulligan restrictions. There are 3 mulligans total per team. One person can use all 3, or you can use the mulligans on long drive or closest to the pin attempts, whatever you please. 3 is the total, NOT 3 per person!
- Proper golf etiquette is expected. Please be considerate. Replace divots, repair your ball mark plus another, and rake bunkers.
- The golf cart driver will assume responsibility in the event of an accident, and could be required to pay any and all costs to replace or fix any damages caused.
- Speed of play: this course can be played in this format in approx. 4 hrs. Because it is a "best ball" format, DO NOT spend time looking for errant shots in the woods, fields or streams when you have a playable alternative. Consider your lost ball a donation to Laytonsville and move on. Timely play is desirable so that we can be at the banquet around 2:30pm and so that all participants can enjoy a delay-free round. The course management reserves the right to give one warning for slow play, and the second infraction will result in that team being directed to move to the next Tee and forfeit that hole. This has never happened, so don't be the first!
